

<p>Go across the railway bridge to the electrical substation.</p> <p>1. Unscramble this sign and rule out the place given by the second word. (Anagram)</p>		<p>Carry on down Entwistle Hall Lane for 250m.</p> <p>2. You are not looking for the place where this sign was made.</p>	
<p>Continue down the road and along Hob Lane for 500m.</p> <p>3. Rule out the place connected with the sum of the digits missing from this sign.</p>		<p>Cross the road and follow the path along the side of Wayoh Reservoir 600m.</p> <p>4. Eliminate the place name similar to the 'yellow' plant</p>	
<p>With your back to the sign go over the grassy hill heading for the football pitch. 300m. <i>DO NOT carry on down the path to the dam.</i></p> <p>5. Add up the digits of the date that Turton FC was established to rule out another place</p>		<p>Leave the football field by the vehicle entrance and turn right. 50m.</p> <p>6. Use the two letters missing from this picture to cross off a place on your map.</p>	
<p>Turn left along 'Horrocks Rd and Horrocks Fold' and then go in to the graveyard on your left. 50m.</p> <p>7. Stand near this grave with Florence Watson on your right. On your left, Ruth and Paul's surname will show you another place to eliminate</p>		<p>Leave the graveyard by the same gate and turn left. Continue along the lane for 50m.</p> <p>8. The answer is not the property name above this pineapple. Rule it out</p>	

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<p>Carry on along the lane for 100m.</p> <p>9. Eliminate the answer associated with the name of house nearest this</p>		<p>Turn right and go up to junction of Middle Lane with the main road. 100m.</p> <p>10. Cross out the answer given by the number below this letter 'H'</p>	
<p>Turn right towards the village centre. 300m.</p> <p>11. Eliminate the answer associated with the name of this house that is on your right.</p>		<p>Go to the cross roads and turn right. Continue to the Barlow Institute. 400m.</p> <p>12. Rule out the location missing from this photo (Anagram)</p>	
<p>Carry on along the road for 400m. On the right just before the Methodist Church. <i>(don't confuse the working church with the converted chapel that is now a house)</i></p> <p>13. Rule out the answer given by the knocker on the door to the left of this sign</p>		<p>Cross the road and go in to the Methodist Church yard.</p> <p>14. Find this grave and rule out the place associated with one of the Prifti family. (anagram)</p>	
<p>15. Rule out the place indicated by the number of carved faces on the walls outside the Methodist church</p>		<p>16. This grave gives you the name of one of the locations. Eliminate it from your enquiries</p>	

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<p>Leave the graveyard and cross the road</p> <p>Turn right by the Black Bull and go along the path to Wayoh for 250m. Before turning left on to the dam....</p> <p>17. Rule out the answer linked to the name of Stan Cooper's dog.</p>		<p>Carry on along the dam for 250m.</p> <p>18. Eliminate the answer associated with 3 x the number of spikes missing from this picture</p>	
<p>Turn right and continue along the side of the reservoir.</p> <p>Turn left at this sign and head along the concessionary path up to Entwistle. 1km.</p>		<p>19. How many arches are under this bridge? Rule out the clue associated with this number.</p>	
<p>Carry on up the stepped path to the Entwistle carpark. Turn right and go along Entwistle dam and up the lane towards the Strawbury Duck. 1km.</p> <p>20. Rule out the answer associated with the name of this caravan</p>		<p>Carry on along the path towards the Strawbury Duck. 50m.</p> <p>21. The answer is nothing to do with the name of this beer garden. Rule it out.</p>	

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
